

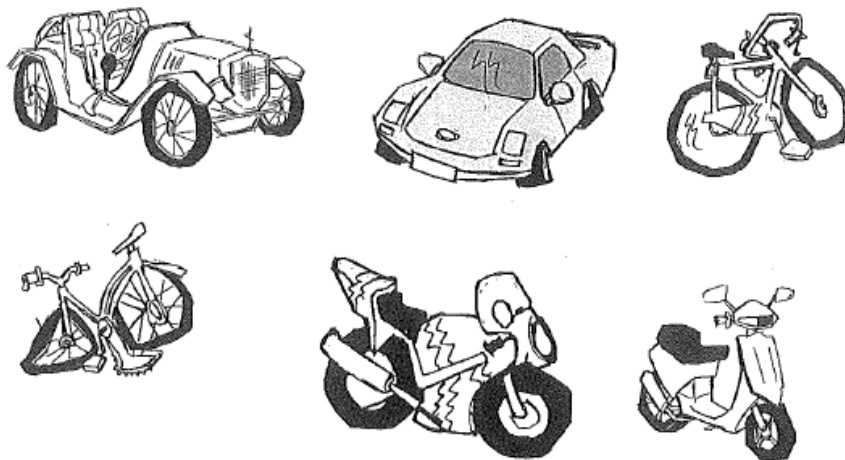

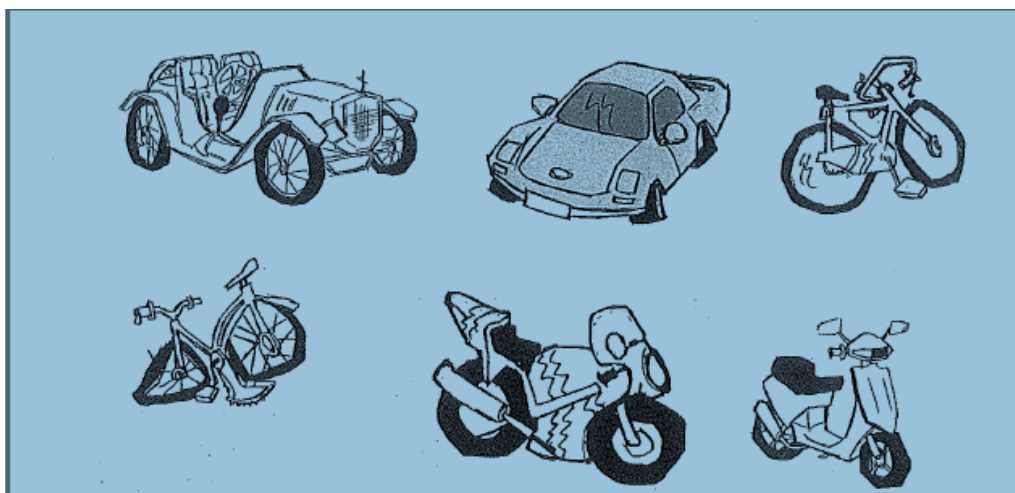
A With your information and that of your college guess the price of these items.

3. The modern car is more expensive than the big motorbike.
4. The old bicycle is worth 2 times less than the new bicycle.

Steps
